There continues some discussion of holding the business portion of the annual meeting separately, as the layout of the Ore House doesn't lend itself to details being clearly heard.

We anticipate needing volunteers for early registration, timing and split calling, traffic coordination; and two people in the chute and three to compile results.

Hopefully those who have not volunteered in the past will do so for the Corrida, so those who seem to work every Strider race will get to run with the Crazyies.

We have several items of business to take care of at the January meeting. The meeting will be at 7 p.m., Jan. 7th, from Greg Ohlsen's house, 1169 East Alameda. In addition to finalizing plans for the new Corrida, we have to discuss the 1986 Santa Fe Run-Around. Main items about the Run-Around are race director(s) and early setting of the date. A few
