Coe coos!

In the running news:

Tony Sandoval won the Old Santa Fe Trail Run in a world-class time of 28:50. The world record for 10k on the road is 28:30, just 20 seconds faster. Tony seems to be fit to run quite well in the Oregon Track Club-Nike Marathon Sept. 9.

Seb Coe, England's new world record holder in the 1,500, also now holds the world records in the 800 and mile. His time for the 800 = 1:42.4, for the mile is 3:49 and for the 1,500 is 3:32.03, rounded to 3:32.1. Steve Ovet, England's other great runner, just missed Coe's 1,500 meter record with a 3:32.11 clocking, which is rounded to 3:32.2!

Graydon Anderson's Moonlight run drew 12 - 14 runners and 4 dogs. The event started and finished at the Aspen Vista parking lot, ran up to Tesuque Peak and back. The organization was perfect and the weather cooperated to make an enchanting run. The moonlight shed an unusual silver light to illuminate the blue spruce in a memorable way.
