Santa Fean, Dave Segura, running his first marathon at age 20 apparently set a world record for 20 year old marathoners and an American record for the fastest first marathon. His time, 2:13.58, automatically qualified him for the Olympic trials.

Albuquerque 7km Homecoming Run:

Won by Tim Childress in record time. Fred Maes improved his race pace by averaging nearly 6 min. per mile. Fred's son, Dan won the 10 and under 1 mile run. Other Santa Fe folks made proud showing but details are not all available.
