A Special Announcement from our Race Director - Santa Fe Runaround

Striders:

First, the Runaround location is being changed this year. I know this is going to be disturbing for many people, and I myself would like to continue running from the Plaza, but a few matters have made this difficult. The Striders' last few monthly meetings were devoted to this subject, and the tough decision was finally made. I personally made the motion to change the venue, and was "rewarded" with the race director honors.... The reasons for moving the race were: the exorbitant costs of using the Plaza and City Police, the difficulty in getting sponsors to underwrite those costs, and nobody would volunteer to be the race director for that location. In retrospect, the community is fairly angry about the gnarled traffic problems during the national biathlon last fall, so perhaps a low profile event is in order now.

Also new is a 5k event, run simultaneously with the 10k event. Our last runaround had fewer than 200 people and the club felt we were excluding most of the runners in the area as well as reducing our income each year. Without the \$800. bill for police protection and with having a 5k run, the club isn't so dependent upon sponsors (we needed four last year).

The race will be south of Santa Fe on a frontage road paralleling I-25. It is a beautiful course and although it doesn't have the interesting neighborhoods we are used to, it is scenic, safe (two intersections), and fast! It runs from Waldorf school westerly on Rabbit Road to the RR tracks and back. The school has generously offered their area for parking and registration, and so far, the Runaround looks alive and well; for a while we had our doubts.



Running Tips

On striding....

"Learn to 'stride.' After each easy run, spend 5 to 10 minutes running 'strides' on grass or a soft trail. Concentrate on running with long, smooth strides for about 100 yards at a 5k race pace." Kate Delhagen

On hills....

"When running hills, whether in races or in training, remember to run at a good, steady pace until you crest the hill and pick up momentum again on the downside. Avoid "stalling out" just before you get to the top, and emphasize short, quick steps with brisk arm action."

APRIL FUN RUN_ Dale Goering 983-6616


Date- Sunday April 19
