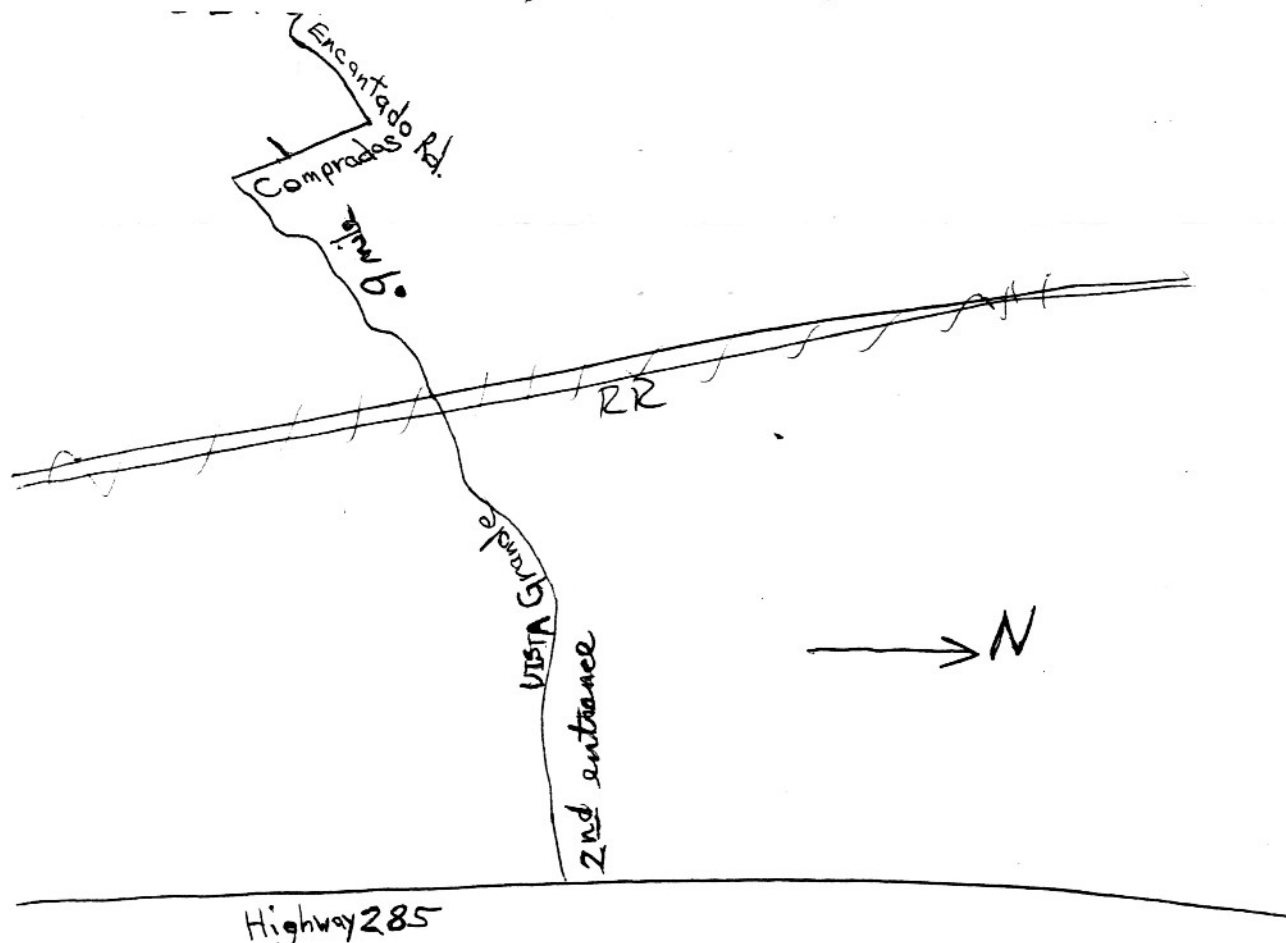


Happy Mother's Day!

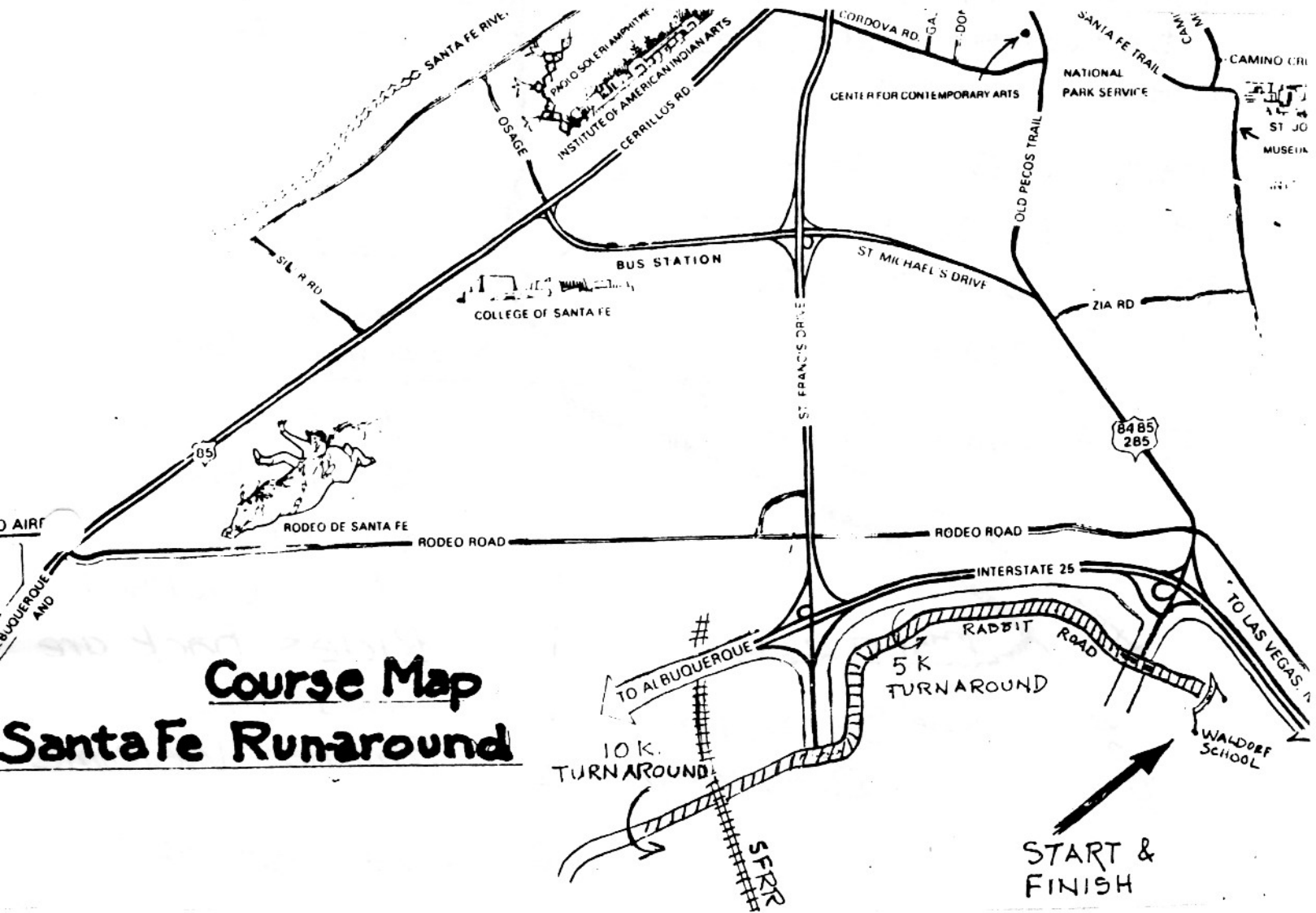

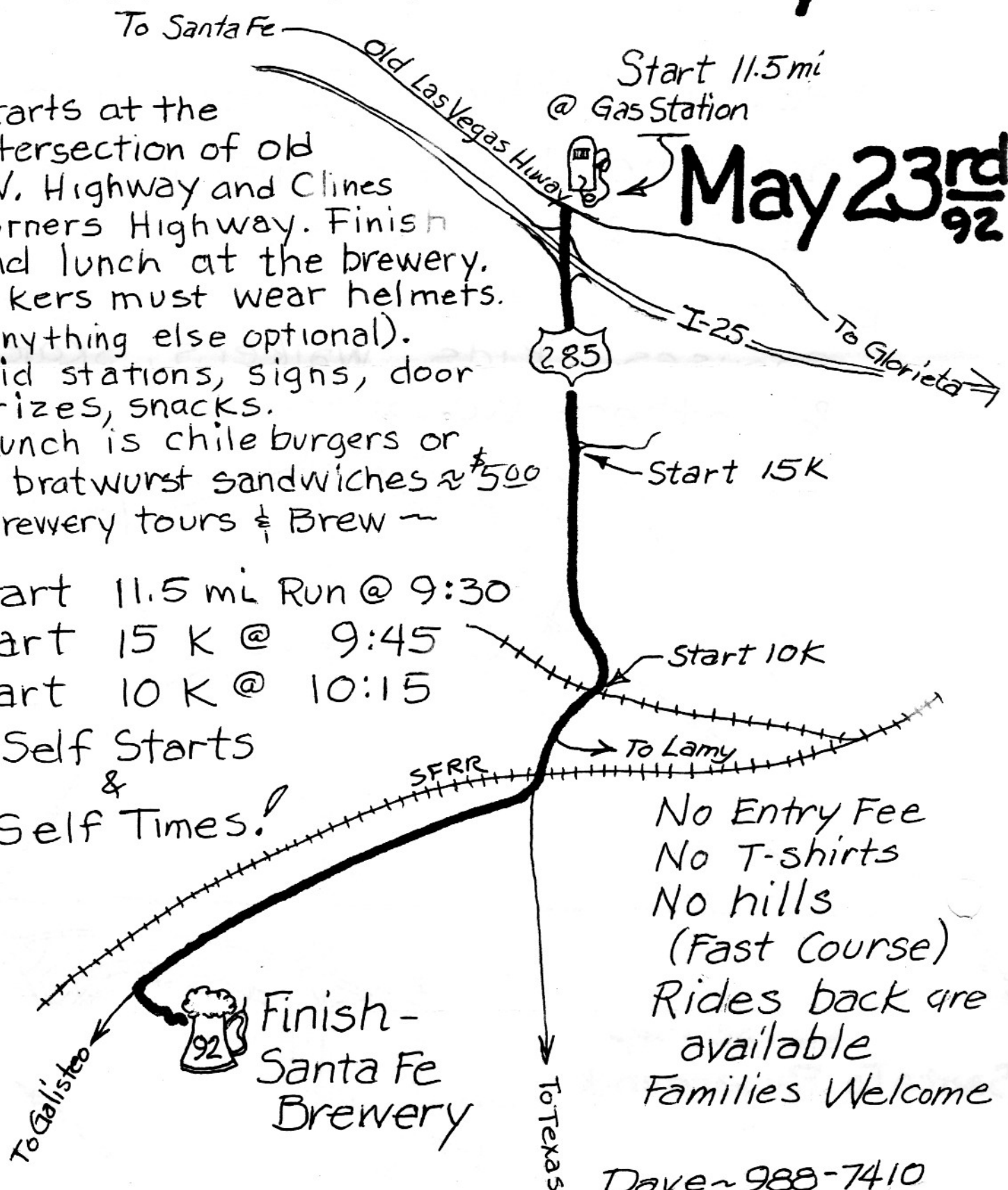
