The Butterfly Run

The first rule of successful racing: Show up on time. The first running of the Pojoaque Fitness Center Butterfly Run was held July 25th. The 10k Started at 7 AM. I arrived at 7:03, in time to see the runners leaving the starting line. Without picking up my race packet, I followed the crowd, greeting many friends as I caught and passed them. The 10 k course followed dirt trails that twisted around the gently rolling hills of the Pojoaque Pueblo. Throughout the run we had spectacular views of the Jemez and Sangre de Cristo mountains, plus the rugged terrain of the valley in between. The Pueblo went all out and had well stocked and manned aid stations. The course had several out-and-back sections, so we could see the leaders. The 5k course was over the same route, with the same fast downhill to the finish.

The race provided refreshments in the shade of the new Pojoaque fitness center. Sean Tynan and Magdalena Thorsell, both of Albuquerque, were the winners of the 10 k, which had a total of 112 finishers. Jon Capron and Kelly Dix were the winners of the 5 k. There were 163 finishers in the 5k.

Race director Liz Roybal put on a great event! I'll look forward to next years race. And remember to get there on time!

La Luz Trail Run

The 1999 La Luz Trail Run, held on August 1st, was the first time it has been produced by the Albuquerque Roadrunners and they did a splendid job. The run is one of the few in the country authorized to pass through a wilderness area, as its founding pre-dates the wilderness designation of the Sandia crest area. If you're not familiar with the run, it covers 9 miles, 1.8 on asphalt, 7.2 on single track trail up to the Sandia Crest, total climb, 4600ft. Again the Fleet Feet running store sponsored the race, and served as a packet pickup and ad hoc runners' expo and meeting site on the Saturday prior to the race. Again many Striders performed well, most notably Shirley Van Slooten, first masters woman, and Erica Larson, 3rd woman overall.


