Western States Report

There has been only one runner over age 70 that has finished the Western States 100 mile run and that is the great Ray Piva. The last time I saw Ray was a few years ago when I passed him at WS. He told me the difficulty with aging is loss of balance on rocky roads.

My goal at the 2002 Western States was to be the second over 70 runner to finish. The run up the road at the start takes you on the Squaw Valley, CA ski run to Immigrant Pass. This went very well for me. The course at the Pass had to be changed because a recent fire had wiped out one of the trails and they needed to make up distances. They did a terrific job of putting in a beautiful downhill trail above timberline. It was here that I fell, banged up my knee and COULD NOT GET UP. A runner came along and lifted me. After a short rest and a few Advils, I was able to continue and at Mile 25 I was feeling good again. I caught up with some South Africans who were going at my pace and we were enjoying some fun conversation but at Mile 35 the heat started to bother me. I took a salt tablet and one minute later started throwing up. By the time I reached Michigan Bluff-Mile 55, I was only two minutes under the cutoff time. But the run from Mich Bluff to Mile 63 - Forest Hills is an easy down hill (I thought). But it was at 11pm and far more rocky than I remembered it. That was because my balance was not what it used to be and I missed the cutoff by 10 whopping minutes. I thought this was my last hurrah but who knows. There has been only one runner over 70 who has finished the Leadville 100. I will let you know after August 18 if there is still only one.
